At Roka VTC, support is advancing the Fashion & Design Department, showcased through students' impressive demonstrations in dressmaking, carpentry, electrical engineering, and masonry. Elimu remains committed to equipping youth with market-relevant skills and structured transition support, positioning Muyeye and Roka VTCs as hubs of excellence shaping brighter futures for young people in Kilifi County.



#### Elimu Familia Stawi Celebrates Cohort 3

Staff, caregivers, and children had an amazing time at the Elimu Resource Centre as we celebrated the successful completion of Elimu Familia Stawi Cohort 3 across Karima, Mijikenda, and Upewoni Schools. The event brought together caregivers, children, school leaders, facilitators, and partners to honor 14 weeks of life-changing learning, resilience, and growth.







Through the program, caregivers and children gained practical skills in positive parenting, communication, nutrition, hygiene, emotional well-being, and financial literacy, tools that foster safer, healthier, and more nurturing home environments. Caregivers shared inspiring stories of strengthened parent-child relationships, increased confidence, and improved management of household resources. The celebration was graced by Elimu Founder, Nina Chung, and Mireille Linga from MaKly Parent & Child Centre, Switzerland, whose partnership has been instrumental in the program's success. ## Celebrating Impact, Growth, and Partnership



We were honored to welcome the incoming and outgoing Presidents of The Charis Foundation (TCF) from Canada, Brad Klinck and Peter Roebbelen, for a threeday visit celebrating 10 years of partnership. Since TCF's initial grant in 2016, Elimu has grown from a small town space serving 100 students daily to a four-storey Resource Centre hosting up to 300 learners. The visit highlighted Elimu's work in digital learning, vocational training, and community transformation, including the Cisco Networking Academy, Digitech Lab projects, and the newly completed plumbing workshop at Muyeye Vocational Training Centre under the CoVEx project.

During the visit, Brad and Peter also participated in the Digital Reading Program celebrations at the men's and women's prisons, supported exam preparations at Malindi Education Centre, and joined a lively Elimu Familia Stawi session, where children learned about nutrition and caregivers received personalized consultations. Over three days, they witnessed firsthand the transformative impact of this partnership uplifting families, empowering learners, and expanding opportunities for youth across Kilifi County. We are deeply grateful to The Charis Foundation for their unwavering support in building brighter futures for our community.



### Walking the Journey Together: Home Visits

As part of our commitment to supporting learners, Elimu conducts home visits for sponsored students, spending meaningful time with both students and their parents. In October, these visits provided a closer look at the transformative impact of the Stay in School project, revealing not only academic progress but also improvements in family well-being, confidence, and overall resilience.



During the visits, parents expressed heartfelt gratitude, noting that the sponsorship has been life-changing. Funds that would have gone toward school fees are now used to support other siblings, household needs, and daily essentials. Students shared a renewed focus on their studies, free from the worry of being sent home due to unpaid fees. These visits reinforced Elimu's belief that education extends beyond the classroom, and by walking alongside our students and their families, we nurture hope, resilience, and opportunity, transforming lives and strengthening communities together.
